

Control plan of external parasites

Need/issue: External parasitism.

Aim: To know the ectoparasites affecting lambs, to use the most appropriate product to control the parasitism, and to set preventive measures.

How to implement:

- Quarantine (3 weeks) of all new animals entering the flock.
- Avoid contact with other flocks.
- Disinfect facilities twice a year.
- Controlling ectoparasites in adult animals.
- Disinfect and disinfect common tools and machinery.



Description:

- It is important to know the cause of itching, scratching or damage in animals.
- Therefore, in the presence of ectoparasites, proper sampling and correct identification will allow the farmer to carry out an appropriate treatment.





















Expected benefits:

- Improving animal health and welfare
- Improving body condition
- Improving feeding efficiency and higher growth rates

Prerequisites and/or limits:

- Collection of wool and/or skin samples
- Collection of parasite samples
- Sending the samples to the laboratory
- Perform laboratory analysis
